# The current data infrastructure landscape: challenges and opportunities (EUDAT)

- There is no one solution fits all! No need to match the needs of all communities at the same time, addressing a group of communities can be very valuable as well.
- There is no competition but complementary between EUDAT and the other infrastructures.
- Several of EUDAT partners are also key players in EGI and PRACE
- We shouldn't work along this division! In EUDAT the frontiers are not always relevant, where we have "users" which are also "providers" to their communities and work with the others to co-design services.
- Training, education, skills and avoiding pitfalls of data flirting.
- We must have insight, knowledge and collaboration!
