GÉANT perspectives on the Horizon2020 era

- October 2014, Berlin
 - TERENA and DANTE together become the GÉANT Association
 - interim Board and CEO appointed to build a new single organisation
- Objectives of the Association
 - development of advanced network and e-infrastructure services
 - promotion of innovation amongst membership and with others
 - coordination of collaboration amongst membership and in projects
 - development of knowledge, skills and competencies across Europe
 - promotion of consensus in development of e-infrastructure services

Horizon2020 funding mechanism

- Framework Partnership Agreement for GÉANT 2015-22
 - the vessel, not the contents ...
 - 1 + 3 + 3 year specific funding, subject to agreements
 - national funding perhaps 95% of total ecosystem
 - EU funding as "glue"
- Outside Europe
 - increasing importance of global connectivity and services
 - from regional development towards global partnerships
 - EU funding as "fuel"






- Sustainability: GÉANT as European Communication Commons
- Universality: support for all projects and all researchers
- **Reliability**: cost-effective services for knowledge communities: connectivity • federated identity • virtualisation • mobility • trust
- Innovation: the underpinning by which these are delivered

Research infrastructures & e-infrastructures

- Keep the horizontal funding "glue" for e-infrastructures in place
 - avoid geographic and/or disciplinary disaggregation
- Encourage vertical integration of e-infrastructure
 - generalise and commoditise disciplinary/RI service stacks
 - more formal partnerships (and integration?) amongst providers
- Encourage user-led national e-infrastructure coordination
 - most users are nationally funded and serviced
 - GÉANT Association will be governed as a national membership body
 - EGI is moving its governance in this direction
