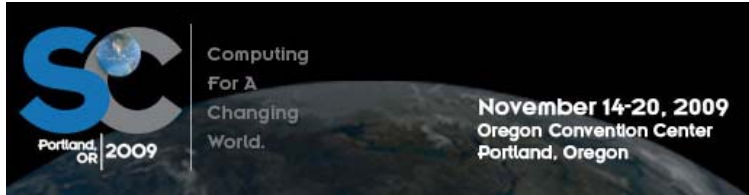
Once the matrix has been built it can be used to focus:
