Why BELIEF?

- Need to facilitate a structured and coherent approach to research and exploitation of research infrastructures
- •To create synergies between elnfrastructure technology providers and users
- •Between Industry & research eInfrastructure Communities.....and policy makers

BELIEF: expanding frontiers

- •To create Synergies and knowledge exchange between the research infrastructure competencies of Europe (all domains)...
- •.....to support the wider and more ambitious vision of elnfrastructures as service oriented knowledge utilities
- •And outreach in mutual collaboration to emerging economies particularly in Latin America and India.

- ➤ A portal with access to a digital library of elnfrastructure documentation; publications (Technology report; research industry handbook)
- ➤ A common communication/dissemination platform for all elnfrastructure Communities: eConcertation forum; search and contact members; case studies

Objectives – relation with eIRG
