From 2007-2010, Neil was Director of OMII-UK at the University of Southampton, which provided and supported free, open-source scientific software to the UK e-Research community.

The Software Sustainability Institute is a national facility for cultivating world-class research through software. Neil's current research is in software ecosystems, breaking down barriers to maintaining research software, cloud computing for science, and the role of software as a research object. He is editor-in-chief of the Journal of Open Research Software, the Chair of the Software Carpentry Foundation Advisory Council, and co-author of Best Practices for Scientific Computing and the Open Science Peer Review Oath.
