Rat für Informationsinfrastrukturen (RfII)

(German Council for Scientific Information Infrastructures)

- Founded in 2013, now in second term
- Composition of the Council: representatives of scientific users (8); providers of information infrastructures (8); the German federal and state governments (4=); the public (4).

Tasks:

- To facilitate and accelerate digital transformation in the sciences on a national level
- The Council monitors transitions in the German academic system at large and gives practical recommendations to academia and the government.

Seminal Paper in 2016: Performance Through Diversity

- → laid the foundations for the creation of the NFDI
- → Available for download in German and English





National Research Data Infrastructure - Aims

The NFDI...

- is a collaborative long-term initiative that will enhance the interconnectivity, future usability and quality assurance of research data
- aims to systematize the vast amounts of research data that is currently often stored decentrally and to ensure long-term access to this data for scientists and researchers
- will set common data management standards and serve as a digital, regionally distributed and interconnected knowledge platform
- will develop a portfolio of services that is available to researchers across regions and institutions
- will be an infrastructure for both providers and users of scientific data, who collaborate in up to 30 consortia



National Research Data Infrastructure - Basics

- Started as a project with a running-time until December 2028
- 3 Calls for Proposals for the funding of up to 30 consortia (= Federations of universities, research institutions, government research institutions, academies and other publicly funded information infrastructure facilities or other relevant actors)
- Financial volume of up to €90m per year (€85m for the consortia)
- Science-driven selection and evaluation process, led by DFG
- Overarching governance structure with Directorate, Scientific Senate and Convention of the Consortia




National Research Data Infrastructure - Timeline

- 16.11.2018: Agreement of the Federal Government and the Länder to establish and jointly fund the NFDI.
- May 2019: Decision to establish the **Directorate** (office) of the NFDI in **Karlsruhe**
- March 2020: NFDI Director Prof. Sure-Vetter in office
- June 2020: Funding decision regarding the first nine consortia by the GWK (Länder and Federal Gov.)
- October 2020: First NFDI consortia become operational
- 12.10.2020: Foundation of the NFDI-Verein
- 2021: Next (second) round of consortia are selected
- 2022: Third and final round of consortia are selected
- 2025: Mid-term evaluation of NFDI structure and governance
