


# e-IRG White Paper 2013: Establish a single *e-Infrastructure* Commons for knowledge, science and innovation...

- ...providing a common interface towards users...
- ...through a joint effort between users, strategic actors and e-infrastructure providers, to attain an ecosystem in which ...
- ...users enjoy the freedom to easily choose and use the services they need, so that ...
- ...they can focus on performing research, in (international) research collaborations.

Implementation of the Commons...

- ... must be accomplished by the European e-Infrastructure initiatives...
- ... but needs to be *facilitated* and *pushed* by
  - the member states (national coordination)
  - the EC (structure of calls etc)
  - the European research communities and research infrastructures
