## Contents of White Paper 2013



Background: Researchers are often confused: Complex e-Infrastructure landscape in Europe – many actors, sustainability issues, interoperability issues, etc

Main concern of WP: Integration of service for research communities and the interoperability and coordination of e-infrastructures.

Follow-up issues: Different aspects on data management and Open Science, cloud computing and legal issues arising from the commercial use of e-Infrastructures
