






Who is RDA? – 7 years of Growth




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






Who is RDA – Geographical Distribution







Background context (March 2020)

- European Commission asked RDA to establish a working group
 - with an international, neutral and inclusive approach
- RDA undertook a rapid response
 - fast track approval of case statement, set a timetable in weeks not months or years
- Sought international co-chairs with domain expertise
 - with links in national / regional Open Science Commons







RDA COVID-19 Working Group objectives


- to clearly define detailed
 - guidelines on data sharing under the present COVID-19 circumstances
 - to help stakeholders follow best practices to maximize the efficiency of their work, and
 - to act as a blueprint for future emergencies;
- to develop recommendations for policymakers
 - to maximise timely, quality data sharing and appropriate responses in such health emergencies;
- to address the interests of
 - researchers, policy makers, funders, publishers, and providers of data sharing infrastructures.







Initially Five COVID-19 WG sub-groups



Each subgroup assigned 2 or 3 moderators from the domain to lead the work and a co-chair to coordinate across









WG/SGs Weekly Cycle

Weekly cycle of "sprints" with meetings of:



4.4.1 Guidelines for Virus Genomics Data

4.4.1.1 Repositories

There are several genomics resources that can be used to make virus genomics sequences available for further research. A curated list can be found in <u>FAIRsharing</u>. Some specific examples are:

- We suggest that raw virus sequence data is stored in one of the International Nucleotide Sequence Database Collaboration (INSDC) archives, as each of these is well known and openly accessible for immediate reuse without undue delays:
 - 1.1. DNA Data Bank of Japan (DDBJ) (Ogasawara O et al., 2020; in FAIRsharing) Sequence Read Archive (SRA)
 - ENA (European Nucleotide Archive at EMBL-EBI; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>), for submission documentation see <u>ENA Documentation</u> (ENA-Docs, 2020)
 - NCBI SRA (in <u>FAIRsharing</u>), for submission documentation see <u>SRA Submission documentation</u> (NIH-NCBI, 2020)
- For assembled and annotated genomes we suggest deposition in one or more of these archives:
 - 2.1. NCBI GenBank (in FAIRsharing), accessible through NCBI Virus (Hatcher EL et al., 2017; in FAIRsharing), for submission documentation see Viral sequence submission documentation (NIH-NCBI, 2020)
 - 2.2. DDBJ Annotated/Assembled Sequences (DDBJ, 2020)
 - 2.3. ENA (EMBL-EBI, 2008 in FAIRsharing)
- Virus Data submitted to <u>GenBank</u> (NCBI, 2013; <u>Benson DA et al., 2013; Clark K et al., 2016</u>; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>) and <u>RefSeq</u> (NCBI, 2013; <u>Pruitt KD et al., 2012</u>; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>) will be available for reuse through <u>NCBI Virus</u> (NCBI, 2013; <u>Hatcher EL et al., 2017</u>; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>)
- 4. There are other archives suitable for genome data that are more restrictive in their data access; submission to such resources is not discouraged, but such archives should not be the only place where a sequence is made available.
- 5. Before submission of raw sequence data (e.g., shotgun sequencing) to INSDC archives, it is necessary to remove contaminating human reads.

4.4.1.2 Data and Metadata Standards

A list of relevant genomics data and metadata standards can be found in <u>FAIRsharing</u>, some specific examples are:

- We suggest that data is preferentially stored in the following formats, in order to maximize the interoperability with each other and with standard analysis pipelines:
 - 1.1. Raw sequences: <u>_fastq</u> (<u>Cock PJA et al., 2009</u>; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>); optionally compress with gzip
 - Genome contigs: <u>fastq</u> (<u>Cock PJA et al., 2009</u>; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>); if uncertainties of the assembler can be captured, <u>fasta</u> (<u>Pearson WR et al., 1988</u>; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>) otherwise; optionally compress with gzip
 - 1.3. De novo aligned seguences: .afa
 - 1.4. Gene Structure: .gtf (in FAIRsharing)
 - 1.5. Gene Features: .gff (in FAIRsharing)
 - 1.6. Sequences mapped to a genome: <u>sam</u> (<u>Li H et al., 2009</u>; in <u>FAIRsharing</u>) or the compressed formats <u>bam</u> (in <u>FAIRsharing</u>) or <u>.cram</u> (<u>Fritz MH et al., 2011</u>). Please ensure that the used reference sequence is also publicly available and that the @SQ header is present and unambiguously describes the used reference sequence
 - 1.7. Variant calling: <u>.vcf</u> (in <u>FAIRsharing</u>). Please ensure that the used reference sequence is also publically available and that it is unambiguously referenced in the header of the .vcf file, e.g., using the URL field of the ##contig field
 - 1.8. Browser: .bed (in FAIRsharing).


