

e-Infrastructure Commons is the political, technological, and administrative framework for an easy and costeffective shared use of distributed electronic resources across Europe.

e-IRG outlines Europe's need for a single "e-Infrastructure Commons" for knowledge, innovation and science [e-IRG Roadmap, 2012]

e-IRG stresses the need for e-Infrastructure coordination at the national level and strong national building blocks, enabling coherent and efficient participation in European efforts [e-IRG Roadmap, 2016]

Role of National Nodes, in the implementation of the e-Infrastructure Commons and its instantiation as the European Open Science Cloud [National Nodes, 2019]

e-IRG addressing the good practices of coordination within and across e-Infrastructures and thematic Research Infrastructures [White Paper 2021]

e-IRG thematised the coordination among the European e-Infrastructures and the need for collaboration on various levels to realise the concept of the e-infrastructure Commons and its instantiation as the European Open Science Cloud [White Paper 2022]

Context



e-IRG has been working on the topic of coordination between thematic and generic infrastructures at institutional, national, regional and EU levels, as well as among the generic infrastructures themselves for quite some time now, and has published the <u>e-IRG National Nodes document</u> in 2019 and the <u>e-IRG White Papers 2021</u> and <u>2022</u>.

In this session and next period e-IRG will shift the focus back to the better cooperation between generic and thematic infrastructures (in particular e-Infrastructures and Research Infrastructures) and the planned cooperation between ESFRI, EOSC and e-IRG, including through the upcoming ESFRI-EOSC joint Task Force. In particular, attention will be given to the important role of e-Infrastructures and Research Infrastructures in EOSC.


This is also well connected to the Research Infrastructure high-level presidency event on <u>The Potential of Research Data: How Research Infrastructures Provide New Opportunities</u> <u>and Benefits for Society</u>. Finally, as highlighted in the <u>December 2022 e-IRG Prague</u> <u>workshop</u>, liaison and interoperability among the EU thematic Data Spaces and the transversal EOSC Data Space is required and the role of e-Infrastructures in this link needs to be highlighted.
