Coordination Meeting with the e-Infrastructures and EOSC-A (virtual, 11.05.2023)

- Stakeholders becoming increasingly important for implementation of the ERA
- Important to have a proper body to be able to represent various stakeholders
- Current no such body for the e-Infrastructures available,
- Once the e-Infrastructure Assembly is established it is very important that ESFRI is informed so that the Forum can be included in the list of ESFRI Stakeholders

- e-Infrastructures are different from the Research Infrastructures in the sense that RIs often have a clearer research community connected to them
- → **General agreement** to form an e-Infrastructure "Assembly" from the responses received; details to be agreed among e-Infrastructures

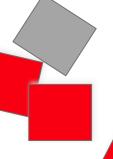






Coordination Meeting with the e-Infrastructures and EOSC-A (virtual, 11.05.2023)

- the meetings that took place recently (also December ones) and the interest shown are a sign of greater attention/interest for more structured cooperation and closer relationship among e-Infrastructures and also e-IRG
- it is mutually beneficial for e-IRG and the e-Infrastructures that there are these stronger connections to influence agenda/strategies of each other
- role of e-IRG in the Forum would be a neutral trusted party, possibly
 facilitating activities via the e-IRG secretariat







Responses from the e-Infrastructures - GÉANT:

- GEANT finds:
 - a. the convening power of e-IRG and
 - b. the way the e-IRG membership is structured very helpful

and therefore as a neutral body, we find **e-IRG** is well-placed to facilitate conversation.

- There are many, many changes in the environment and we are only seeing the beginning.
- We used to be a few e-infras rubbing along fairly easily.
- We are now in an environment, where we have EOSC and EuroHPC, dataspaces, the EDICs coming up + all the new legislation and policy out of the digital decade, twin transitions, security union. Plus the funding fragmentation. We need to digest that and I think we will all be set served if we do some of this digesting together.
 - Having e-IRG promote and support joined-up thinking is very welcome.
- We also welcome the attendance of ESFRI.
- Equally, we would like to thank e-IRG in making an observer position available.

Responses from the e-Infrastructures - EGI:

- EGI support the proposed observers (representative from the e-Infras and EOSC-A) to e-IRG,
- Welcome the idea proposed by Jana (ESFRI CHair) of having the e-Infrastructure group represented in the ESFRI-EOSC joint task force.
- e-IRG represented in the e-Infrastructure assembly meetings as observer, to streamline comms and alignment.
- e-Infrastructure assembly complementary to e-IRG, i.e. a discussion platform of the e-Infrastructure members, which provides an external contact point to this stakeholder group at EU level + to e-IRG itself.
- offer our network of user communities and other relevant human networks as sounding board for policy topics relevant to e-IRG and the other e-Infrastructures.
- The frequency of meetings of the e-Infrastructure group could be quarterly with agendas set up with the contribution of all e-Infrastructures.

If e-IRG was available to provide secretariat support, we would be happy to consider this opportunity.





Responses from the e-Infrastructures: OpenAIRE

- welcomes the collaboration with e-IRG and is happy to:
- Support the idea of an e-Infrastructure group representative as an observer in e-IRG meetings.
- Involve an e-IRG representative in the e-Infra assembly with e-IRG having a neutral/observer role.
- to first try quarterly meetings (at least one physical potentially coinciding with the eIRG physical meeting) and adapt frequency as needed.
- Chairing of meetings: we could foresee a rota of chairs from e-Infrastructures who will be responsible for setting the agenda and keeping the minutes. Agenda setting would be done with consultation from all, including eIRG.
- we can bring representatives of our respective communities in meetings (or design actions to involve them), depending on e.g., success stories, good practices, new developments
 Depending on results, we can revisit our plans/actions in one year.







Responses from the e-Infrastructures - PRACE:

- Very welcome to allow observer from e-infrastructures and EOSC-A in e-IRG meetings.
- For the e-infra-assembly we would prefer to have e-IRG involved as manager / organisator with a neutral/ facilitating role.
- it should be an e-infra-assembly and **not include per se other related initiatives and users.** However, these groups can be invited if needed.
- If the assembly would **meet twice a year** would be a good option. One as remote meeting and one F2F in conjunction with a e-IRG WS.
- I think e-IRG secretariat could prepare a draft agenda by asking for topics before the
 assembly.
 - The minutes are always a pain, but needed, otherwise, you don't need to organise a meeting. We would like to ask if the e-IRG secretariat could prepare the minutes.







Responses from the e-Infrastructures - EUDAT:

- EUDAT is continuously positive about maintaining the regular discussion across einfras.
- Organising a lightweight e-infrastructure assembly still requires some consideration as
 the e-infrastructure landscape on an European level is changing. The increase in a
 number of ESFRI initiated research infrastructures that are more or less thematic einfrastructures, the establishment of EuroHPC JU, and the EOSC Co-programmed
 Partnership has totally reshaped the landscape. Both the European Commission and
 Member States are for example, governing the latter two.
 - Taking this into consideration we propose that the **role of EOSC Association as a coordinating body** and a meeting platform for e-infrastructures must be considered carefully before creating additional bodies.







- The feedback from e-Infrastructures was discussed in the e-IRG delegates meeting this week (Tuesday, 20.6.2025)
 - It is clear that all e-Infrastructures are positive and have accepted the creation of the Assembly
 - The main e-IRG decision is that it would be left to the e-Infrastructures to decide on actual structure and modalities and come back to e-IRG with the details.
 - This will be communicated to the e-Infrastructures next week
